

## Water Agent on Duty for Boundary County water users on a monthly basis in 2024



The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) will provide a water agent on duty in Bonners Ferry on a monthly basis beginning on April 17, 2024.

Luke Bates, Senior Water Resource Agent for IDWR, will staff office hours at the Boundary County Annex Building, 6566 Main St., Bonners Ferry, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Office hours are set up to accommodate walk-ins for convenience on a first-come, first-served basis.

IDWR's commitment to property owners and water users in Idaho includes responsive communication with water users and effective management of Idaho's water resources. To that end, IDWR staff is creating a public outreach opportunity for Bonners Ferry and Boundary County residents by hosting monthly office hours.

Anyone with questions about water use, water rights, proposed stream channel alterations, temporary water usage and more are encouraged to stop by and talk to Bates.

In future months, the IDWR agent-on-duty office hours will normally occur on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month, projected through April 2025.

IDWR appreciates the partnership with Boundary County in making the office space available at the Annex building and assisting with notifying the public about this opportunity.
